

- 2 VEHICLE RESTRICTIONS APPLY, Maximum dimensions; Height 2.5m, Width 2.1m and Gross Weight 3.5 tonne.
- 3 Dhimurru Aboriginal Corporation and the Northern Land Council advise this access permit is not a licence or permission to conduct commercial tourism on Aboriginal land.
- 4 Wanuwuy is a registered Aboriginal Sacred Site complex under NT Law.

There are over 58 recorded sites of significance within the complex.

- Permit conditions and other directions which may be in force from time to time are designed to maintain the natural and cultural values of the area. and to limit the possibility of damage to sites of significance by visitors.
- 5 Gayngada Twin Eagles is one of approximately 58 sacred sites in the vicinity of Wanuwuy. Senior landowners have requested that visitors do not stop (swim, fish, picnic or camp) on the southern side of this site. Note: Penalties of up to \$20,000 can be imposed for breaches of the Sacred Sites Act.




